


COMMON CURRICULUM


COMMON CURRICULUM

TOPICS OF INQUIRY REQUIREMENTS:

- At least 3 credits in each TOI
- One Laboratory Science (TOI-6L)
- 6 Unique Course Subjects
- Minimum of 21 TOI Credits
- Complete 9 credits through a Focus Area in TOI or a
 Theme

COMPETENCY REQUIREMENTS:

- 2 Writing (W) Courses
- 2 Quantitative (Q) Courses
- Second Language through Elementary Level 2
- Information, Digital, and Media Literacies (IDML)
- Dialogue
